The venue Isle of Marstrand	<p>The venue of the conference is the <i>Isle of Marstrand</i>. The <i>Isle of Marstrand</i> is on the West Coast (45 km North of Gothenburg /Göteborg, i.e. Sweden's second city). Famous spot in Scandinavian history, well known conference centre, world-sailing metropole and highly attractive summer resort. Called <i>The Pearl of Scandinavia</i>.
